

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ATTACHMENT D - ASSUMPTIONS AND CONDITIONS

This Attachment D contains only those Assumptions and Conditions which are specific to the prices set out in paragraph 7 of Supplement No. 2 and are in addition or represent a variation to the Assumptions and Conditions stated elsewhere in the Contract in particular Contract Annex 18.

1. ASSUMPTIONS

1.1 ALN/CASA/DASA prices for In-house Airframe activities and ALN prices for In-house Role Equipment activities are based on average 1997 economic conditions.

For BAe the price for In-house Airframe activities is a fixed price up to end of 2001 and a firm price at 2001 economic conditions thereafter.

1.2 Where prices are expressed in DEMe at average 1997 economic conditions they are based on the following exchange rates:

1 DEM = 981,9324 ITL 0,3520 GBP 84,4381 ESP 0,5764 US \$ 4,4018 SKR 3.3664 FFR

- Prices for equipment including Supplier Role Equipment, BAe Inhouse Role Equipment and AEA/HEA are based on the same economic conditions and exchange rates as detailed in Contract Annex 18, Assumptions 1.1 and 1.2.
- 1.4 The commitment figures for LLTI are composed as follows:
 - average 1997 e.c.s. and exchange rates for airframe
 - e.c.s. and exchange rates as detailed in Contract Annex 18, Assumptions 1.1 and 1.2 for equipment.
- 1.5 Not used.
- 1.6 The prices have taken into account the findings of the Production Readiness Review.

- 1.7 It is assumed that in respect of Contract Annex 18 Conditions 2.12 to 2.14 an international procedure will be agreed which will among other issues provide for adequate financial cover before any remedial work under a respective claim is undertaken.
- 1.8 Prices assume the availability of any dispensations necessary to allow Contractor Flying without TACAN on Production Aircraft when at a standard of CRR 1 or above. No provision has been made for fit of TACAN equipment to allow flying without such dispensations.
- 1.9 The Contractor is able to fulfil his obligations under the Contract in relation to the incorporation of CPs in the Weapon System on the following basis:-

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- 1.10 The Customer will transfer to EF title to all airframe and equipment items allocated to six Tranche 1 WS at Block 5 standard and paid for under Supplement No. 2. In exchange title will vest in the Customer of airframe and equipment items subsequently allocated to six Tranche 1 Weapon Systems to be delivered at Block 8 Standard.
- 1.11 The Customer will only make claims for Liquidated Damages (LDs) on aircraft to be delivered post signed Amendment No. 4 to Supplement No. 2.
- 1.12 The Weapon System Price used for the calculation of Liquidated Damages is €.



- 1.14 The prices contained in these change pages do not include the price impact of any approved CPs over and above those stated to be included at the time of signature of Supplement No. 1 and 2.
- 1.15 Equipment warranties on aircraft to be delivered post signed Amendment No. 4 to Supplement No. 2 will be confined to the residual warranty remaining on the equipment.



2. CONDITIONS

In addition to those qualifications and assumptions stated elsewhere in the Contract the prices detailed in Paragraph 7 of this Supplement No. 2 exclude the costs of the following items and the costs arising therefrom:

2.1 The following CPs agreed to be included in Contract Annex 1 WSPS for Supplement No. 2 and are over and above those listed in Contract Annex 18 Assumption 1.11/Attachment 1.


