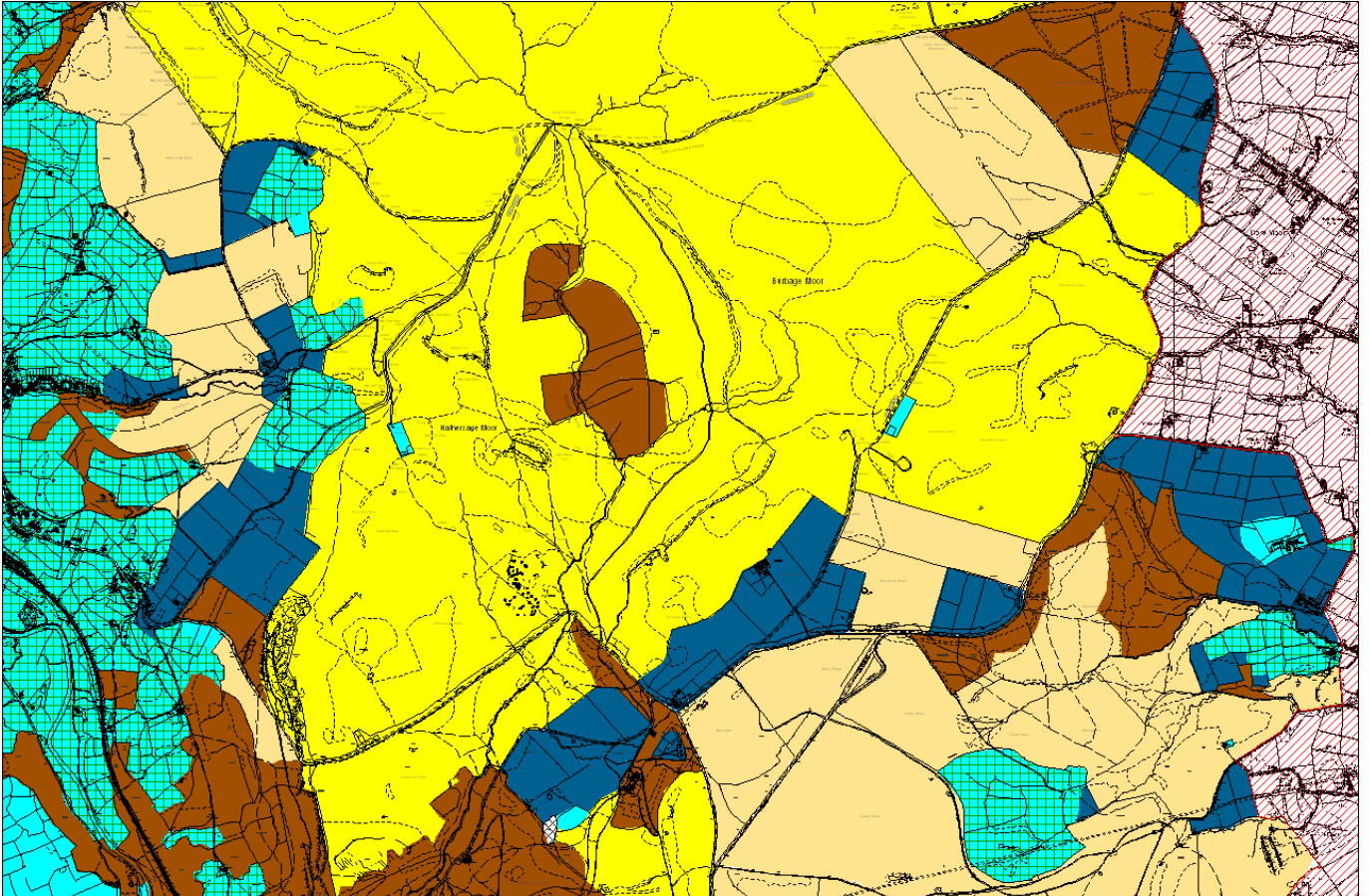

Bright yellow area

Overall character: Open Wastes and Common

Hathersage Moor

Description: Part of Hathersage wastes and commons prior to Parliamentary Enclosure in 1830. Despite allotment, this area remained as open moorland.

Burbage +Houndkirk Moors

Maps used in analysis: Dore Parl. Encl. Map, 1822 1st ed. 2", 1840 1st ed. 25" OS map, 1880.

Description: Part of Dore wastes and commons prior to Parliamentary Enclosure in 1822. Despite allotment, this area remained as open moorland.

Cyan area

Overall character: Post-1650 Encl - Regular: Piecemeal/Award, no details

W moorland enclosure

Maps used in analysis: Hathersage Parl. Encl. Map, 1830 1st ed. 2", 1840 1st ed. 25" OS map, 1880

Description: Part of Hathersage wastes and commons prior to Parliamentary Enclosure in 1830. This enclosure was laid out after 1840 and before 1880.

E moorland enclosure

Maps used in analysis: Dore Parl. Encl. Map, 1822 1st ed. 2", 1840 1st ed. 25" OS map, 1880

Description: Part of Dore wastes and commons prior to Parliamentary Enclosure in 1822. This enclosure was laid out after 1840 and before 1880.

Buff area

Overall character: Enclosed Moorland

NE area

Maps used in analysis: Dore Parl. Encl. Map, 1822 1st ed. 2", 1840 1st ed. 25" OS map, 1880

Description: Part of the wastes and commons prior to allotment in 1822. Despite enclosure, this area appears to have remained essentially moorland.

SE areas

Maps used in analysis: Dore Parl. Encl. Map, 1822 Hathersage Parl. Encl. Map, 1830 1st ed. 2", 1840 1st ed. 25" OS map, 1880

Description: Most of this area was part of Dore wastes and commons prior to Parliamentary Enclosure, although the southernmost part was within Hathersage. Despite enclosure, the land appears to have remained essentially moorland.

Dark blue area

Overall character: Post-1650 Encl - Parliamentary Enclosure Award

Maps used in analysis: Dore Parl. Encl. Map, 1822 Hathersage Parl. Encl. Map, 1830 1st ed. 2", 1840 1st ed. 25" OS map, 1880

Description: Part of the wastes and commons of Dore (north-eastern half) and Hathersage (south-western half) prior to allotment under their respective Parliamentary Enclosure Awards. This land had been enclosed before 1840, but is only marked in outline, so that the earliest map to show the field boundaries is the 1880 OS map.
