I have managed to have a look at the Report now and have a few comments.

Under 'Restrictions' the scope of works says that due to the sensitivity of the surrounding land you have been advised that extraction of timber and stumps from the site is not an option. It still is an option, but you would not be able to take stumps etc out across the SSSI/SAC.

Reference is not made to the protected species that might occur on site. Reference must be made of any protected species that might be encountered, i.e. if any are then work will stop and Natural England will be contacted for advice. My concerns is that water voles might turn up or great crested newts and even bats in the larger trees. All contractors must be aware of this possibility and the appropriate action taken if necessary.

For the de-silting of the ditches, we do have concerns regarding the deposition of silt on the sides of the ditches. This will cause a bund which may add to prolonged flooding of the surrounding areas. The spreading out of the depositions might help with this but you must check with the Environment Agency to ensure that you are allowed to do this as, in my experience, the silt would need to be removed from the floodplain. These ditches might be okay, but you should check - try pedro.collins@environment-agency.gov.uk.
